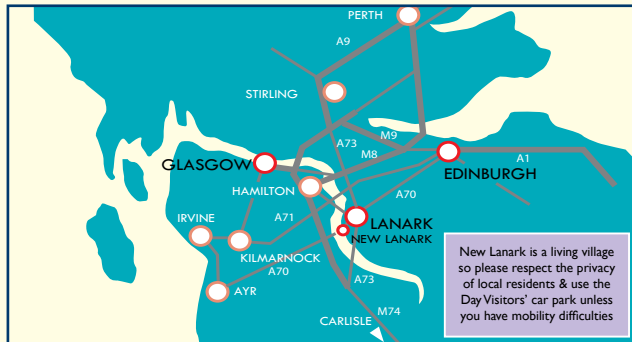

#### HOW TO FIND US - BY CAR

New Lanark is 1 mile south of Lanark and around an hour from Glasgow (M74/A72) and Edinburgh (A70). From the south, the village is 30 mins from M74 Junction 13/Abington - main trunk road to Edinburgh. Postcode for Sat Nav: ML11 9BY.

#### BY TRAIN

The nearest train station is in Lanark (1 mile) connecting to Glasgow Central & Motherwell. There is a local bus service between Lanark Visitor Information Centre and the village.
